HECKER VILLAGE BOARD MINUTES

July 9, 2013

President Charles Kujawski called the July 9th, 2013^h regular Board Meeting to order. After reciting the Pledge of Allegiance, the following members answered roll call: Charles Kujawski, Rich Happel, Jim Mueth, Trisha Maddox, Arnold Eckart, Chuck Wagner, Gary Wittenauer, Lori Amann and Annette Schreder. Absent was Bob Phillips.

Jim Mueth made a motion seconded by Gary Wittenauer to approve the June 11, 2013 Board minutes. Voting all ayes, motion carried.

Rich Happel made a motion seconded by Gary Wittenauer to approve the treasurer's report and pay all bills submitted for the month of July. Voting all ayes, motion carried.

Mayor's Report:

- Rreported to the Board that the Village of Hecker website is up and running. The website's address is hecker.illinois.gov.
- He also stated that the park's security camera is in place and running.
- President Kujawski also discussed the changes that need to be done with the stop signs and speed limit signs in town.

Committee Reports:

- POLICE—A citizen has reported unusual activity at the Freedom Cemetery at various times after 10:00pm. The St. Clair County police have been contacted.
- PUBLIC WORKS—The Fire Department is getting an ISO audit.
 The Village's fire hydrants are being painted.
- PARKS & RECREATION—Trisha stated that they are waiting for mulch to be delivered for the old playground. A discussion was held on posting rules for the park. It was also asked that parking curbs be placed on the parking areas to prevent cars from driving onto the grass.
- STREETS—Jim Mueth passed out a proposal from Monroe County Engineer Aaron Metzger to fix drainage issues on West Back St. and North Park St.
 - A motion was made by Arnie Eckart seconded by Rich Happel to repair the drainage issues. Voting all ayes, motion carried.
 - Oil and chipping of the streets was also discussed. Jim Mueth will talk with Monroe County about doing the job and dividing the streets to do a third of the town at a time.
- ZONING—Permits have been received from 310 & 320 Hillgard for the proposed Group Homes. A Special Use Permit will also need to be filed.

President Kujawski passed out the current **Prevailing Wage Act Resolution #13-003** for review. Chuck Wagner made a motion seconded by Trisha Maddox to approve the Prevailing Wage Act Resolution. The following roll call vote was taken:

Misc. Business: A discussion was held on the sign that the Hecker Country Store has out on the sidewalk.

A request was made to have several street closures on August 17th for the Tikki Trot Run held in conjunction with the St. Augustine Kirchenfest. Rich Happel made a motion seconded by Trisha Maddox to approve the street closures for the Tikki Trot Run. Voting all ayes, motion carried.

President Kujawski presented the Board with a quote from Coast to Coast to purchase a new Color Copier/Scanner/Fax machine with the cost of the machine being paid from the Water Fund. Gary Wittenauer made a motion seconded by Chuck Wagner to approve the purchase of the new Color Copier/Scanner/Fax machine. Voting all ayes, motion carried.

A discussion was also held on drafting an Ordinance for any type of business coming to the Village of Hecker to obtain a Business License.

Gary Wittenauer made a motion seconded by Jim Mueth to adjourn the meeting. Voting all ayes, motion carried.
