Drive-Thru Utility Payment Box Now Available



We are now offering a drive-thru utility payment drop-box. It can be accessed from the new Park/Office parking lot. The existing box in the Monroe Street door will also remain available for use. We do also offer Auto-Pay which automatically debits out of your preferred checking or savings account on the 28th day of each month.

REMINDER

The carts having the blue lids are for recycling only. Items accepted include...PAPER – Newspaper & inserts, magazines, shopping catalogs, junk mail, office paper, wrapping paper, etc. GLASS JARS & BOTTLES – Brown, green & clear (No light bulbs or window pane glass) TIN/STEEL CANS – Soup & vegetable cans (No scrap metal) CURROGATED CARDBOARD – Please break-down boxes. We also accept single-ply cardboard (cereal boxes, soda & beer cartons) ALUNIMUM CANS – Beer & soda cans PLASTICS – Household plastic containers – #1 thru #7 (look for the recycling logo, it will show the number) milk jugs, 2 liter soda bottles, juice & detergent containers, etc. These items are mixed together and will be sorted at the plant(1 container for all)
