Rules Concerning Alternate Transportation for the Village of Hecker

Pursuant to **Village Ordinance 17-007**, all persons operating a utility vehicle or golf cart on Village streets must comply with the following rules:

- (a) Must obey all traffic laws of the State of Illinois and the Village of Hecker;
- (b) Must be operated only on Village streets that have a posted speed limit of 35 miles per hour or less, except where prohibited;
- (c) May not be operated on Illinois Routes 156 or 159, or any streets, highways, or roadways under the jurisdiction of the Illinois Department of Transportation, except to make a direct crossing at the following designated streets: Jefferson Street at Route 159, 2nd Street at Route 156, and Juanita Road/East Lincoln Street at Route 159;
- (d) A person who is operating or who is in actual physical control of a utility vehicle or golf cart on a roadway while under the influence of alcohol or drugs is subject to Section 11-500 through 11-502 of the Illinois Compiled Statutes (625 ILCS 5/11-500 through 11-502);
- (e) Utility vehicles and golf carts shall not be operated on sidewalks or in Village parks other than parking areas;
- (f) All operators of a utility vehicle or golf cart must adhere to the child restraint laws pursuant to the Illinois Compiled Statutes;
- (g) Any operator or passenger of a utility vehicle or golf cart must be in a sitting position while the vehicle is in motion.

WAIVER OF LIABILITY
(RELEASE)

Release executed this ____ day of _____, 20____, by _____, whose address is _____, Hecker, Monroe County, Illinois, hereinafter for convenience referred to as "Releasor."

In consideration of being permitted the use of a golf cart or utility vehicle on streets of the Village of Hecker, Monroe County, Illinois, Releasor, for himself/herself and his/her personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin, releases, waives, discharges, and covenants not to sue the Village of Hecker, Monroe County, Illinois, its officers, agents, and employees, all hereinafter for convenience referred to as "Releasees," from all liability to the Releasor, his/her personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin, for all loss or damage, or any claim or damage therefore, on account of injury to the person or property, or resulting in the death of Releasor, whether caused by the alleged conditions of the Village streets or the negligence of any party resulting from, or occurring by reason of, Releasor's operation of, or occurring while the Releasor is operating, a golf cart or utility vehicle on roadways under the jurisdiction of the Village of Hecker, Monroe County, Illinois.

Releasor agrees to indemnify Releasees, and each of them, from any loss, liability, damage, or cost Releasees may incur due to the operation by Releasor of a golf cart or utility vehicle within the corporate limits of the Village of Hecker, Monroe County, Illinois.

Releasor agrees that this release, waiver, and indemnity is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of the State of Illinois, and if any portion of this Release is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance will, notwithstanding, continue in full force and effect.

Releasor, being of lawful age, in consideration being permitted to operate a golf cart or utility vehicle on roadways under the jurisdiction of the Village of Hecker, Monroe County, Illinois, does for himself/herself, his/her personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin, hereby release and forever discharge Releasees of and from any and every claim, demand, action, or right of action, of whatsoever kind or nature, either in law or in equity, arising from or because of any bodily injury or personal injury, known or unknown, death and/or property damage resulting, or to result, from any accident which may occur as the result of Releasor's operation of a golf cart or utility vehicle within the corporate limits of the Village of Hecker, or any activities in connection with such use, whether by negligence or other cause.

Releasor further states that he/she has carefully read the above Release, knows the contents of the Release, and signs this Release and his/her own free act.

Releasor further acknowledges that the terms of this Release are contractual and not a mere recital.
