(A) <u>KEEPING BARKING DOGS AND CRYING CATS.</u> <u>Harboring.</u> It shall be unlawful for any person to knowingly keep or harbor any dog which habitually barks, howls or yelps, or any cat which habitually cries or howls to the great discomfort of the peace and quiet of the neighborhood, or in such manner as to materially disturb or annoy persons in the neighborhood who are of ordinary sensibilities. Such dogs and cat are herby declared to be a public nuisance.

) Petitions of Complaint. Whenever any person shall complain to the Police Department that a dog habitually barks, howls or yelps or a cat habitually cries or howls is being kept by any person in the Village, the Police Department shall notify the owner of said dog or cat that a complaint has been received and that the person should take whatever steps are necessary to alleviate the howling, yelping or crying.
