**Friday, June 5th & Saturday June 6th, 2020:** Save the date Village Wide Yard Sale

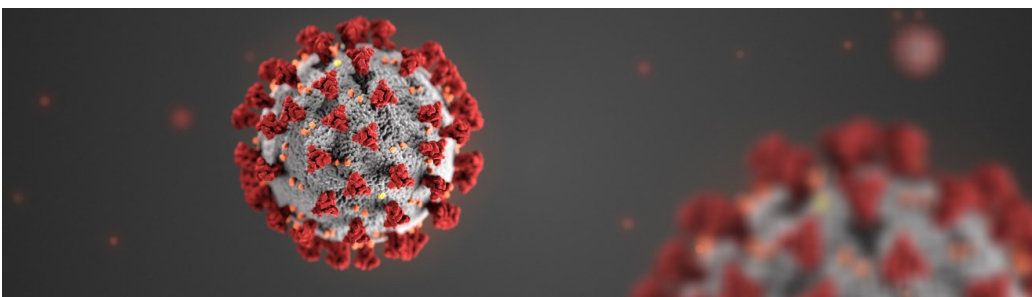


Citizens & Utility Costomers,
