Due to mandated testing by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency the village will now be testing our drinking water for Monochloramine, Di-chloramine, Free Ammonia, Total Ammona, Nitrate \& Nitrite. This is all above our previous Total Chlorine \& Free Chlomine testing.
