Important Parade Information

We are excited to be having the Hecker Quasquicentennial Parade. This event will have a major impact on the streets and highways in town. Please be patient with the event and plan your travel to and from your house before or after the parade if possible. Consider walking to the parade and picnic if you are able to.

The actual parade route will start at the Hecker Village Park at North Second at West Washington. It will head south on Second Street and turn east on Monroe Street, then south on Main Street, east on Back Street, north on Nike Street to Freedom Ave and finally turning south on Park Street where walkers may disperse. Vehicles will continue south to Monroe Street and disperse.

The parade line up will close Melinda Lane, Eldondale Drive, all of West Jefferson Street and North Second Street north of Washington Street. These street will be closed and inaccessible from 2:30 p.m. - around 5 p.m..

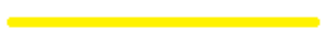
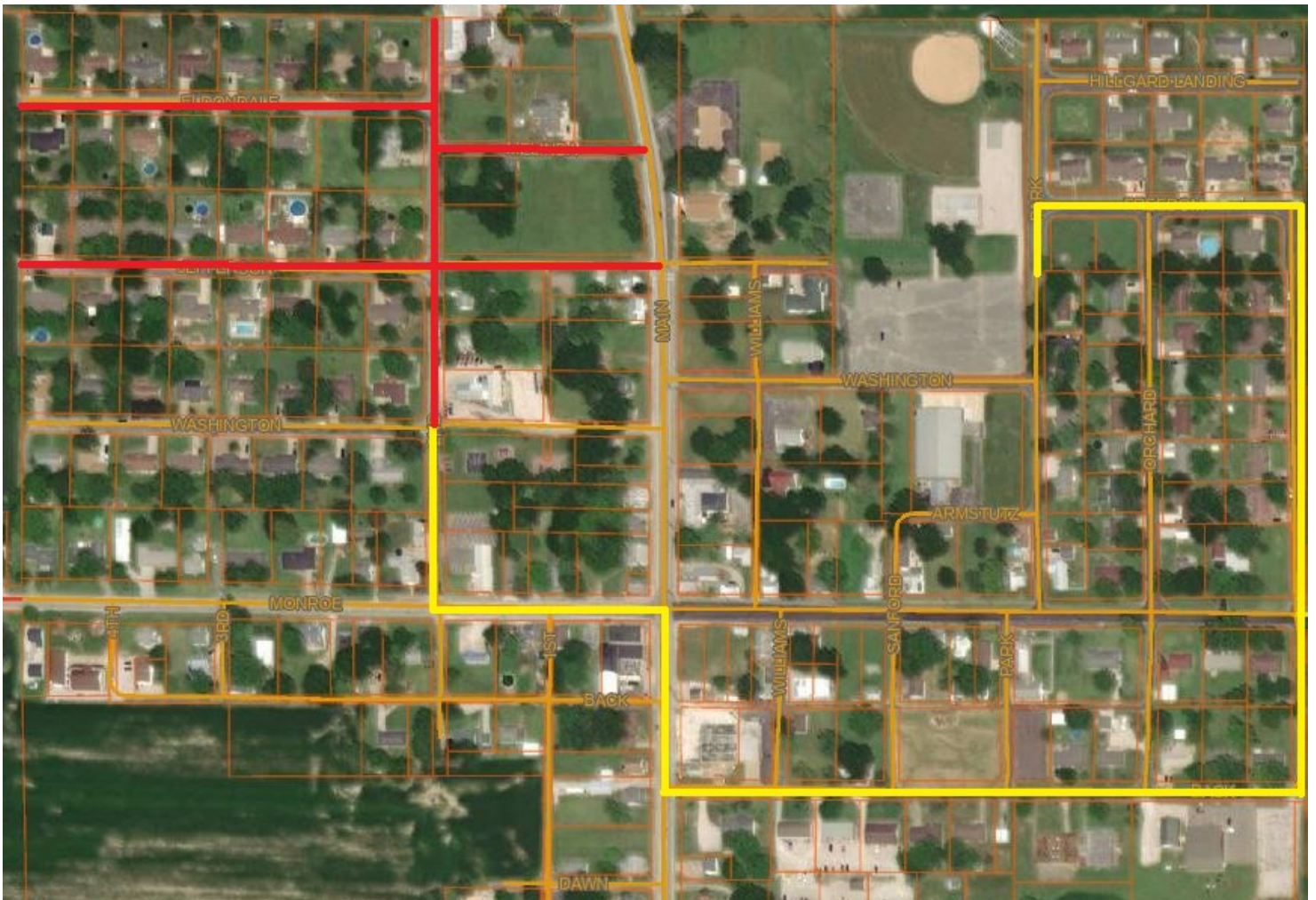
