

HECKER VILLAGE BOARD MEETING

February 11, 2020

Committee Reports:

- Police/EMA: Rich Happel brought to the Boards attention the recent break-ins of cars in surrounding areas. He asked that everyone keep their eyes and ears open here in town.
- Water: R & M has the propane tank in place at the water tower. Things will be switched over on the 18th.
- Zoning: President Kujawski said he will be advertising for a new Zoning Administrator. Several inspections were done. The Firehouse will have a final walk-thru and also a final walk-thru will be done on the Joe Gregson house. A permit was issued for a fence on Monre St.

Quasiquicentennial Committee: Discussed the upcoming fish fry to be held on Friday, February 28, 2020 from 3:00pm-8:00pm at the Hecker Community Center

President Kujawski received word from Attorney Myron Hanna about the Sexual Harassment Ordinance. An on-line training course will soon be mandatory.

The following Special Event Liquor Licenses for 2020 and A Special Use Liquor License for 2020 were discussed.

Voting all ayes, motion carried.
