Clerk: Annette Schreder reminded the Board Members to turn in their Economic Interest letter by the next meeting. Also reminded the Board of the upcoming Consolidated Election on April 6, 2021 and that Board Member Gary R. Wittenauer will be a write-in candidate.

Committee Reports:

Police: Anytime there is a moving or active situation, the Monroe County Sheriff should be called. If it is a stationary issue, the Village of Hecker can be called.

Streets: James Mueth reported that street sweeping of loose rock will take place sometime in April or May.

Parks: The Restrooms will open on Friday, March 12, 2021.

Zoning: Discussion was held on a RV Trailer being parked on a residential lot and seems to be occupied and hooked up to utilities. The occupant has been given a deadline of April 15, 2021 to comply with the Ordinance. An RV can be legally parked on a lot as a stored trailer and showing no signs of utilities being used.

TWM has completed the drawings for the project. Also discussed was for TWM to get the information out for bids and to have them due and opened on the next Village Board Meeting Date.

Douglas Van Buren made a motion seconded by Trisha Maddox to have TWM put out for bid the Water Main Extension south of town on Rt. 159. Voting all ayes, motion carried.

Plans are still underway to have the Quasquicentennial Picnic in late August.

Trisha Maddox made a motion seconded by Rich Happel to adjourn the meeting. Voting all ayes, motion carried.
