Committee Reports:

- Water & Sewer: HTC still needs to complete their contract with the Village. The new Aerators have been installed at the sewer plant. James Liefer has been hired to do some excavation and fill in with dirt and grass seed at the plant.
- Parks & Recreation: the yard sale will be postponed. Park will possibly open up the end of June.
- Streets: East Monroe, Back Street and Country Village Lane will be oiled and chopped this fall. Discussion was held on possibly having to grade some streets.
- Zoning: Several Permits have been issued. President Kujawski will put an ad in the June Newsletter for a new Zoning/Ordinance Administrator.
