James Mueth made a motion seconded by Douglas Van Buren to approve the July 14, 2020 regular Board minutes. Voting all ayes, notion carried.

Douglas Van Buren made a motion seconded by James Mueth to approve the treasurer's report and pay all bills submitted for the month of August. It was also decided to close three accounts at Regions Bank and move them to First National Bank of Waterloo. These accounts are Freedom Cemetery CD, Cemetery Trust CD and Cemetery Trust Savings Account. Voting all ayes, motion carried.

Mayor: Only one letter of interest for the Zoning Administrator's position has been received.

There are funds in the budget for any Emergency Funding. Deterding Tree Service has been contracted to come to Hecker to help with the recent storm damage and pick up tree debris. Residents should put their debris close to the road so Deterding can pick up and put thru their chipper.

Committee Reports:

- Water & Sewer: Will meet with Chad Rhutasel to outline what fees the Village will be responsible for concerning new EPA fees. Still working on a contract with HTC. The generator has been used due to recent power outages.
- Parks & Recreation: Trisha Maddox said 16 families responded to the Village Wide Yard Sale that was held on July 31 and August 1.

Quasquincentennial Committee: The committee has decided to postpone the Parade and Picnic until sometime next year. The gun raffle and the grill raffle will still take place on September 12, 2020 with an event to be held at the Hecker Community Center from 4:00pm till 8:00pm with the raffle being held at 8:00pm.

Discussion was held on the new street signs and posts that will be going up soon in Hecker. A bid of \$3,845 from Warning Lights for the posts and brackets was discussed. Rich Happel made a motion seconded by Trisha Maddox to accept the \$3,845.00 from Warning Lights to purchase the posts and brackets for the new street signs.

August 29, 2020 the Hecker Fire Department will have a ribbon cutting ceremony for the unveiling of the new Fire House. The Ribbon Cutting and Open House will be held from 10:00am – 2:00pm.
