

HECKER VILLAGE BOARD MEETING

October 9, 2018

President Charles Kujawski called the October 9, 2018 regular Board Meeting to order. After reciting the Pledge of Allegiance, the following members answered roll: Charles Kujawski, Rich Happel, Jim Mueth, Trisha Maddox, Arnold Eckart, Douglas Van Buren, Gary Wittenauer, Guy Briley, Lori Amann and Annette Schreder.

James Mueth made a motion seconded by Trisha Maddox to approve the September 11, 2018 regular Board minutes. Voting all ayes, motion carried.

Gary Wittenauer made a motion seconded by James Mueth to approve the treasurer's report and pay all bills submitted for the month of October. Voting all ayes, motion carried.

Mayor: The Halloween Kick-off Party will be at the Hecker Community Center on October 31, 2018. Doors open at 4:30pm. There will once again be costume judging, free hotdogs, chips, popcorn, and a free drink.

Kay Clemens was in attendance to promote October as Violence Prevention Awareness Month. President Charles Kujawski read a Proclamation declaring October as Violence Prevention Awareness Month.

Dave Bruss was in attendance to let the Board know that his internet/phone line was cut when reseeding the retention pond area was being done. He was getting the problem fixed but wanted to let the Board know what happened.

Committee Reports:

- Sewer—President Kujawski presented the Board with a quote from Visu-Sewer for sewer maintenance.
Arnold Eckart made a motion seconded by Gary Wittenauer to accept the quote of \$7,074.00 to include the lining of pipes, root cutting, jetting and doing camera work of the lines. Voting all ayes, motion carried.
