Old Business:

A motion was made by Deanna Louveau and seconded by John Miller to approve the Minutes for April 4, 2016 meeting.

It was decided to table the Health Code additions/subtractions (Chapter 17) for the next meeting so that we can obtain a copy of the contract for trash pickup with Reliable Sanitation.

Open Floor: There were no residents present for open discussions.

New Business:

Concerns about the patrons of the Back Street Wine & Dine driving through the drainage ditch and not exiting through the parking lot exit were discussed. Guy will talk to the owners about a possible barricade along the north side of the parking lot to eliminate the problem.

Discussions began on Chapter 21 Liquor License. John Miller suggested that Section A stating that "license applicants must be a resident" of the Village be eliminated.
