December 13, 2023 Utility Rate Increase

The village is required by law to have all utility type funds (such as water and sewer) to be selfsufficient or collect all that is needed to operate. In the last two years we have seen maintenance costs, especially those with material expenses, double in price. We plan on recoating the water tower in 2024 and the projected cost is 500% higher than our last recoat in 2006. Therefore there will be a very noticeable increase on your water rates effective January 2024(payable February 2024). Sewer rates will see a much smaller increase. Customers' can help keep maintenance cost down by discontinuing the flushing of "Butt Wipes". These wipes cause regular failures at the treatment plant.
