The Village of Hecker has been experiencing problems with wet wipes and other trash getting caught in the sewer lagoon aerators causing damage to the equipment. This requires the Village to hire a company to clean the aerators and get them operational once again. The cost for this maintenance is becoming significant. We respectfully request that you refrain from throwing any wet wipes, feminine products, cat litter, cotton balls, plastic, etc. into any toilets. Even products marketed as "flushable" may not degrade over time and can cause issues with the sewer network or treatment equipment. Please only throw toilet paper in the toilets. We appreciate your help in reducing the Village's costs and keeping our sewer lagoon functioning properly.
