CODE REMINDERS

27-9-2 BURNING PROHIBITED. It shall be unlawful to cause or allow open burning of agricultural waste, household trash or garbage.

27-9-3 RESTRICTIONS ON BURNING OF LANDSCAPE WASTE. The open burning of landscape waste shall be permitted only on the following conditions: Landscape waste shall be burned on the premises on which such waste is generated; and Landscape waste shall be burned only when atmospheric conditions shall readily dissipate contaminants; and, Landscape waste may be burned only if such burning does not create a visibility hazard on roadways, walkways, or railroad tracks; and, Open burning of landscape waste may only take place during the hours of 7:00 A.M. through 7:00 P.M., on Monday through Saturday, with a person over eighteen (18) years of age in attendance during the entire period of burning; and, No open burning of landscape waste shall be permitted on any streets or roadways; and, No open burning shall occur during periods of time when the Fire Chief or the Chief of Police have determined that atmospheric conditions or local circumstances make such fires hazardous and dangerous.
