IMPORTANT TRASH INFORMATION

Due to flammability of 'lithium-ion' batteries, Illinois EPA prohibits the disposal of all 'lithium-ion' batteries in sanitary landfills and recycling facilities. Once damaged or crushed, lithium-ion (li-ion) batteries will create a fire; therefore, these lithium-ion batteries (or electrical devices containing these batteries) should not be disposed of in the Trash Tote or placed in the Recycling Tote.

These lithium-ion (li-ion) batteries are used in many products such as electronics, laptop computers, toys, wireless headphones, handheld power tools, small and large appliances, electric vehicles and electrical energy storage systems.

Lithium-ion batteries (or those contained in electronic devices) should be recycled at certified "battery electronics recyclers" that accept batteries rather than being discarded in the trash or put in municipal recycling bins. Often Lowe's and Home Depot stores accept lithium-ion (li-ion) batteries for recycling. Additional resources are the "Earth911" database and "Call2Recycle."
