## CODE REMINDERS

27-9-2 BURNING PROHIBITED. It shall be unlawful to cause or allow open burning of agricultural waste, household trash or garbage.

27-9-3 RESTRICTIONS ON BURNING OF LANDSCAPE WASTE. The open burning of landscape waste shall be permitted only on the following conditions: Landscape waste shall be burned on the premises on which such waste is generated; and Landscape waste shall be burned only when atmospheric conditions shall readily dissipate contaminants; and, Landscape waste may be burned only if such burning does not create a visibility hazard on roadways, walkways, or railroad tracks; and, Open burning of landscape waste may only take place during the hours of 7:00 A.M. through 7:00 P.M., on Monday through Saturday, with a person over eighteen (18) years of age in attendance during the entire period of burning; and, No open burning of landscape waste shall be permitted on any streets or roadways; and, No open burning shall occur during periods of time when the Fire Chief or the Chief of Police have determined that atmospheric conditions or local circumstances make
