April 8, 2025

Zoning:

- A fee schedule was presented and reviewed by the Zoning Board. It was presented to the Village Board by Zoning Administrator Eric Sutton. The Zoning Board requested that the increased in fees schedule be posted on the Village's website and posted in the monthly newsletter.
