

HECKER VILLAGE BOARD MEETING

July 8, 2025

President Aaron Eckart called the July 8, 2025, regular Board meeting to order. After reciting the Pledge of Allegiance, the following members answered roll call: Aaron Eckart, Rich Happel, James Mueth, Arnold Eckart, Gary Wittenauer, Eric Sutton, Lori Amann and Annette Schreder. Douglas Van Buren was absent.

President Aaron Eckart recommended Deanna Louveau as a candidate for Village Trustee to fill the unexpired term to April 30, 2027.

Rich Happel made a motion seconded by James Mueth to appoint Deanna Louveau to the Village Trustee position expiring April 30, 2027. Voting all ayes, motion carried,

Deanna Louveau was then sworn into office by Village Clerk Annette Schreder.

After stating an error on the time of the June meeting, James Mueth made a motion seconded by Arnold Eckart to approve the June 10, 2025, Board Minutes: Voting all ayes, motion carried.

James Mueth made a motion seconded by Rich Happel to approve the treasurer's report and pay all bills submitted for the month of July. Voting all ayes, motion carried.

President Aaron Eckart spoke on the upcoming IML Convention to be held in Chicago in September. Aaron voiced his interest in attending as did several other members.

Sheri and Troy Yarber were in attendance to thank the Village for allowing them to sell fireworks in Hecker the end of June. They have already booked their dates for next year.

Committee Reports:

Cemetery: Gary Wittenauer mentioned that there have been several burials in the cemetery so far this summer.

Streets: Street oiling will take place in September. A different kind of rock will be used to cover the oil as the slag previously used is no longer available.

Fick, Eggemeyer and Williamson were approved to conduct the annual Fiscal Year May 1, 2024 thru April 30, 2025 audit.

Gary Wittenauer made a motion seconded by Deanna Louveau to adjourn the meeting. Voting all ayes, motion carried.
